Our licensed Early Years programs include Toddler (18 to 30 months old), Casa (ages 3 to 6 years old), and our Elementary Program spans Grades 1 through to Grade 8.

Why Montessori?

Montessori is an evidence-based, child-centred approach developed by Dr. Maria Montessori in the early 1900s. It is the only educational pedagogy grounded entirely in the developmental needs of children, guiding how learning environments and materials are designed. This approach nurtures each child's social, emotional and intellectual growth at their own pace, helping them develop into confident, compassionate and responsible young adults who love learning.
